Eligibility Checklist

Please review this checklist to make sure this opportunity is a good fit for you, your site and community.

- Have or can get permission from the property owner or decision maker to add a food forest
- Have access to water and a plan for safe and secure tool storage
- Site is publicly accessible and/or the food forest will provide community benefit
- Have at least 500 square feet, can plant at least 5 - 10 fruit trees and can include other plants such as berries, pollinator plants, etc.
- Can commit to engaging community members in the space, including for long-term maintenance (5+ years) and collecting and distributing the harvest
- Have at least 2 staff, volunteers or community members who can commit to maintaining the space (4+ hrs/month minimum) as lead food forest stewards
